## General Terms & Conditions

The annual fees and levies will be invoiced in Term 4 of the previous year. Fees can be paid in weekly, fortnightly, monthly, quarterly or yearly instalments. Preferred method of payment is by direct debit payment plan.

- ◆ Fees paid in advance for the year **attract a 5% discount on tuition fees.**
- ◆ Fees paid quarterly are due on the first day of term.
- ◆ An enrolment referral discount on tuition fees of \$500 per student enrolled is provided to both the referring family and the referred family on enrolment (not for returning enrolments). This will be credited after completing one semester of school.
- ◆ Accounts 14 days overdue without prior arrangement attract a \$25 monthly administration charge.
- ◆ Annual fee concessions due to extreme hardship may be considered on application to the Business Manager. Conditions apply.
- ◆ **Year 6 is a key transition year for many schools. To allow both families and Brisbane Christian College time to prepare school applications and secure positions in their school, Year 6 families must give two terms notice (by the last day of Term 2) of any changes to their enrolment for the following year.**
- ◆ **All other years require the standard one full term notice. Families not intending to return the following year must notify the College by the last day of Term 3.**
- ◆ **Notification after these dates will incur a late notice fee.**

Additional optional charges not listed here include: Snowy Trip (Years 10 – 11), Cambodian Missions Trip, China Cultural Experience Tour, some camps, some specific sporting activities, instrumental music programs and uniform. Uniform is compulsory at Brisbane Christian College.
